# **Eligibility:**

- Essay Writing Competition: Open to students from Grade V to Grade XII

(Entries can be submitted in English or Hindi)

- Drawing Competition: Open to students from PS to Grade XII

(Students of Grade V to Grade XII can submit their entries for both competitions)

#### Theme:

"Quality Champions: Small Steps, Big Impact."

Participants are invited to reflect on how small actions, such as saving water, standing up against bullying, managing time effectively, being honest, helping others, or being disciplined, can lead to meaningful and lasting change. You are encouraged to think creatively and come prepared with ideas and imagination.

#### **Submission Instructions:**

## **Essay Writing Competition:**

Eligibility: Children from Grade V to Grade XII

Instructions:

- a. The essay/article should be written (in English or Hindi) around the given theme.
- b. The essay/article must be the original work of the participant and should not be copied from any source.

- c. Word limits are as follows: 200 words: For children from 5th to 7th grade
- 500 words: For children from 8th to 9th grade
- 1000 words: For children from 10th to 11th grade
- 1500 words: For Children in 12th grade
- d. Please adhere to the word limit.
- e. Please highlight all the references used in the essay/article.
- f. The essay should be typed in Times New Roman font, 12 font size and the print copy of the essay/article should be submitted to the teachers of English/Hindi of the respective Grade.

#### Note:

- a. The content should be legible and readable.
- b. Please provide your details (name, grade, and name of the school) at the end of the essay.
- c. Images and illustrations are not allowed.

Entries should be submitted to the English or Hindi teachers of the respective Grade.

## **Drawing Competition**

- Eligibility: Children from Pre-school to XII grade
- Instructions:
- a. The artwork should be hand-sketched or painted, and A4/A3-sized sheets can be used.
- b. Captions/quotes can be added in English/Hindi/Regional languages. Ensure the text is clear, readable and visually distinct.
- c. The textual description should be limited to 10-12 words.
- d. Entry is to be submitted to the Grade Teacher.
- Note:
- a. The artwork must be original and unique, created by the participant, and the content should focus on the theme. Evaluation will be based on visual impact, originality, creativity, and relevance to the theme.

b. Before handing over the Drawing sheet to the Grade Teacher, ensure that your details (name, grade, and school) are mentioned at the bottom right of the drawing sheet.
The last date for submission of entries is Tuesday, August 19, 2025
All participating students will receive e-certificates.
We look forward to enthusiastic participation from all students. Let us work together to make this event a true success and ensure that no child is left behind.
